- JUNIOR ENTRIES: Please use Junior entry card or write 'JUNIOR' on card if exhibitor is under 18.
- Pavilion opens at 8.30 a.m. on **Thursday 27 August**. Entries to be delivered by 10.30 a.m. Judging will commence at 11 a.m.
- All exhibits to be the product of the exhibitor and locally grown.
- Exhibitor to nominate sections for entry but these may be altered at the discretion of the judge.
- Vegetables will be judged as true to own type.
- NOTE: ** **Sections 10, 19 and 20** to be presented in appropriate sized glass jar or vase for longevity.
- Exhibits may be removed between 5.00 and 5.30 p.m. on the second day of the Show, **after checking with stewards**. NO exhibits may be removed before that time. After that time no responsibility can be taken for safety of exhibits.
