- **Exhibits** to be in the SRA Pavilion **between 8.30 a.m. and 10 a.m.** on Thursday 27 August. No late entries accepted.
- **Cut flower entries will be provided with a vase** unless otherwise stipulated. The stewards are not responsible for returning any personal vases that have been used.
- **NOTE:** Prize money and exhibit collection **STRICTLY between 5.00 and 5.30 p.m. on the second day of the Show**, after checking with stewards. NO EXHIBITS may be removed before that time and NO RESPONSIBILITY can be taken for safety of exhibits.

CUT FLOWERS

Section

No Vases permitted - see above guidelines.

Please keep stems long where possible and ensure dead flowers and leaves have been removed

- 1 FLAT PANSIES IN FLAT CONTAINER or SAUCER, 3 stems. Stems must be uniform length
- 2 CONTAINER OF SWEET PEAS, 3 stems
- 3 CONTAINER OF LIGHT VIOLETS, variegated accepted. Stems to be tied or secured with elastic band.
- 4 CONTAINER OF DARK VIOLETS
- 5 ONE BUNCH OF LAVENDER - LIGHT COLOURED. Stems must be secured with elastic band.
- 6 ONE BUNCH OF LAVENDER - DARK COLOURED. Stems must be secured with elastic band.
- 7 CONTAINER OF CALENDULAS, any colour, no buds
- 8 THREE CALENDULAS, one colour, no buds
- 9 CONTAINER OF MIXED GERANIUMS
- 10 CONTAINER OF GERANIUMS - one variety
- 11 ONE GERANIUM
- 12 CONTAINER OF DAFFODILS, at least 3 varieties. Please keep stems long
- 13 THREE DAFFODILS, one variety. Please keep stems long
- 14 THREE JONQUILS, single variety. Please keep stems long
- 15 THREE JONQUILS, double variety. Please keep stems long
- 16 CONTAINER OF ICELAND POPPIES
- 17 ONE CUT OF STOCK (no more than 4 laterals)
- 18 EXHIBIT OF CUT BULBS - one variety not already mentioned
- 19 ONE CUT OF FLOWERING TREE
- 20 FREESIAS, 3-6 stems
- 21 ONE DUTCH IRIS
- 22 CONTAINER OF DUTCH IRIS
- 23 ONE BEARDED IRIS, any colour
- 24 CONTAINER HELLEBORES, any colour
- 25 ONE BLOOM NOT ALREADY MENTIONED
- 26 CONTAINER OF DAISIES
- 27 CONTAINER OF PRIMULAS
- 28 CONTAINER OF PRIMULA POLYANTHUS
- 29 CONTAINER OF MIXED FLOWERS, bulbs & shrubs allowed
- 30 CONTAINER OF FLOWERS, one variety not already mentioned
- 31 CONTAINER OF NATIVES
- 32 CONTAINER OF MIXED BULBS
- 33 ONE SPIKE OF ORCHID

- 37 POTTED FERN
- 38 POTTED SUCCULENT or CACTUS, one variety only

- 40 **HANGING PLANTS.** Any plant in hanging basket. Can be multi planted or single planted.
