SITE RENTAL REGULATIONS

THERE MAY BE CHANGES – MAKE SURE YOU READ ALL REGULATIONS

No sites will be held without observation of all Regulations on this and following pages.

This applies to ALL site holders. Please do not ask for exceptions.

Site allocation is at the direction of the Show Secretary and relevant Ground Space Steward.

For application to be considered, all applicants for a site at Condobolin Show must complete, sign and return the accompanying Space Application Form along with non-refundable deposit of \$25 and a copy of current Public Liability Insurance Policy certificate for a minimum of \$20,000,000 (Twenty Million) with an APRA approved insurer.

Applicant will be advised if space is available. If space is not available deposit will be refunded.

SITE DEFINITIONS

1. The SRA Pavilion houses competitive classes and schools' exhibits. A limited number of small display and trade sites (3m wide x 2m deep or less) may be available. Please note a 2nd preference, in the event that 1st choice is not available.

NOTE: Nothing sharp or metallic may be placed on the floor; therefore, all furniture, display stands etc. must have rubber or fabric feet (or placement on mats). If in doubt, please consult Chief Pavilion or Ground Steward before set-up.

Sites accommodate free-standing displays and site-holders should provide their own shell-scheme/walls, if required as nothing can be fixed to pavilion walls; also provide own tables but up to 2 chairs per site can be provided. Power may not be available to some positions.

2. Outdoor sites for commercial businesses and itinerant traders.

Ensure that metreage on application **includes towbars, guy ropes etc** to give adequate frontage (width) and if camping on the ground, ensure that all rental and power requirements are included on your application; and for each night outside the Show period if applicable.

3. Pavilion verandah – Under cover positions on the 9-metre-deep verandahs on two sides of the pavilion.

4. Agricultural and Industrial trading & display sites from small to large, suiting machinery, vehicles and agricultural businesses among others.

5. Site rental charges are for trade/display site rental with no power. If power is required at the trade site, note additional fee.

If camping is required on the ground (between sites and riverside), please note on application. A separate charge is applied for the camp site, and power is inclusive for the camp site only.

6. Site Fees:

PAVILION	\$20 per metre frontage (or part thereof), but note, the minimum fee is \$50
OUTDOOR	\$20 per metre frontage (or part thereof), but note, the minimum fee is \$50
AGRICULTURAL	\$10 per metre frontage (or part thereof), but note, the minimum fee is \$50
POWER TO SITE	\$40 per Single Phase outlet/ \$90 per Three Phase outlet
CAMP SITE	\$15 per night on Condobolin Showground. Power to camp site is included.

Deposit of \$25 must be included with space application and is only refundable if cancellations of space are made at least two weeks prior to the Show.

7. Payment by direct transfer details are contained at end these Regulations.

8. Community Displays. On application selected space may be available at a reduced fee to community groups.

9. Ground Entry. Enter ground through Car Gate and proceed in designated lane to gain access to site. Site holders whose site rental is more than \$100 will receive 2 complimentary gate passes if required. Those whose site rental fee is less than \$100 will need to purchase the required number of passes at \$15 per person. Purchase of these additional passes will open in mid-July.

10. Bump In / Bump Out. By 8.30 a.m. each day all vehicles must be unloaded and removed from your site area. **Pavilion opens** to general public at 9 a.m. each morning and closes at 6 p.m. Friday and 5.30 Saturday. Displays are being broken down from 5 p.m.

11. Car parking is available in the designated area between the riverbank and northern side of the cattle and sheep pavilions (ground passes are required), inside the racetrack or outside the showground. There is **NO PARKING** in the trading space area.

Showground speed limit 10 km/hr (walking speed) and movement of vehicles on the Showground during Show hours is for essential traffic only.

12. INSURANCE requirements

- A copy of your Public Liability Insurance Policy Certificate of Currency is to be **included when booking** and space **will only be confirmed when this requirement is met**
- Insurance must be for at least \$20 million
- Location must include “**Anywhere in Australia**”
- Insurer must be APRA approved
- **Condobolin PAH & I Association AND Lachlan Shire Council** MUST be listed as an “Interested Party”. If not already, your agent or broker will do this at once on request
- Should you not have such insurance the Condobolin PAH & I Association can provide this cover for an additional \$25 which must be included with your deposit. Acceptance is at the discretion of the Show Society and no Product Liability cover will be provided.

13. On arrival all site holders must check-in AT THE SECRETARY’S OFFICE before establishing trading and camping sites. Site holders who arrive outside business hours may camp in a temporary position until confirmation of location is given.

NO sites are to be established until Public Liability requirement has been met.

14. Food Vendors are required to be fully compliant with the Food Standards Code of the NSW Government Food Authority and all current Food Safety Practices and General Requirements as well as Lachlan Shire Council’s Policies, Procedures and Guidelines (www.lachlan.nsw.gov.au). Lachlan Shire Council may undertake inspections of preparation, storage and serving area etc. and may charge the trader for this inspection.

The sale of some food or drink items might be prohibited due to sponsorship or contractual arrangements. Food vendors must carry at least one fire extinguisher of approved type & suitable for use on the display.

15. Water usage must be controlled and not left unattended.

16. There is to be no dumping of water, oil or rubbish on site or adjacent sites. **Oil and rubbish must be removed from site and ground at end of rental period.**

Please break down and compact packaging and other rubbish as much as possible. Garbage bin space fills fast and it is in the interests of everyone on the ground, traders included, to maintain a tidy site to the best of your ability.

17. All electrical equipment is to be fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers, and all electrical leads, tools and appliances must have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. Extension leads must carry a valid test tag and must be fixed overhead away from pedestrian or vehicular traffic. Double adaptors and piggy-back plugs NOT

permitted. Any exhibitor who does not comply will not be permitted to exhibit at the Showground. Gas cylinders must have a current stamp of approval.

18. No space holder shall obstruct the use of any firefighting equipment or electrical switchboards and must maintain free access to such equipment at all times.

19. Gambling. All games-of-chance are strictly prohibited, including disposal of any article by lot or chance, guessing competitions, sale of raffle or Art Union tickets. Collection tins/buckets and any method of fund-raising not permitted.

20. Security. Exhibitors are responsible for adequately securing their property and that of their staff and accompanying people and Condobolin PAH & I Association Inc accepts no responsibility for damage or theft.

21. Dogs. Do not bring pet dogs to the show as they are strictly prohibited, apart from exhibits in the Pet Parade on the Friday (ONLY) which must have been entered with the Secretary prior to arrival on the showground. Assistance and competition dogs are permitted. Any dogs are to be securely tied at all times during Show days and on leash at all other times. Regular visits are paid by Shire Ranger on the days prior as well.

22. Prohibited Goods include the sale of tobacco products, including vapes, and second-hand machinery or vehicles. The use of public address or sound equipment in the pavilion is not permitted by any site holder.

23. Banned Goods by the Federal Council of Agricultural Societies at all Agricultural Shows in Australia are listed on the last page (Page 4) and this Show Society reserves the right to request that a site holder remove any item deemed to contravene these conditions.

24. MOTORISED SCOOTERS are not permitted on the Showground at any time. Mobility scooters designed for the mobility-impaired are allowed.

24. Removal. Machinery, tanks etc must be removed from the Showground within 7 days of completion of the Show in accordance with local Council regulations.

25. Indemnity. The Condobolin PAH & I Association Inc accepts no liability for damages to exhibits by loss, damage, theft, fire, water, storms, strikes, riot or any other cause whatsoever and will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by an exhibitor and it shall be a condition of exhibition that each exhibitor shall hold the organiser harmless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such accidents.

Thursday Closed to public for Pavilion judging. Site holders should advise Secretary's Office if they will require admission on Thursday.

The Showmens Guild of Australasia has agreed that the following lines are banned at Agricultural Shows, Australia wide, as it is our view and aim to protect and attract Families to the Local Shows. Further endorsed by the Federal Council of Agricultural Societies for all Agricultural Shows in Australia.

This ruling applies to all exhibitors and trade sites on Condobolin Showground.

- EXPLICIT DVDS & VIDEOS
- FAKE CIGARETTES

- HORNS & TRUMPETS
- KNIVES (INCLUDING PEN KNIVES)
- METAL AND WOODEN MARTIAL ART NUNCHUCKS
- LASER PEN LIGHTS AND OR LASER TOYS
- LASER POINTERS
- PLAYING CARDS (NUDE OR LEWD)
- PRESSURE PACK FART GAS
- PRESSURE PACK SNOW
- PRESSURE PACK SILLY STRING
- DRUG RELATED GOODS (INCLUDING COCAINE KITS AND BONGS, ETC.)
- STINK BOMBS
- WATER PISTOLS LONGER THAN 150MM
- WATER BOMBS
- BOMB BAGS
- FIRE WALLETS
- BOUNCING BEANS
