- Exhibits may be removed between 5.00 and 5.30 p.m. on the second day of the Show, **after checking with stewards**. NO exhibits may be removed before that time but for the convenience of exhibitors, the pavilion will also be attended on Sunday 25 from 8.30 a.m. to 12 noon.
- After that time no responsibility taken for safety of exhibits.
- All exhibits to be production of exhibitor since August 2023.
- Single exhibits not permitted to compete in collection and vice versa.
- Original product maker's name to be removed from lid by placing, for example, coloured Contact on top.
- Entry ticket to be taped to underside of exhibit.
- **MAKING ENTRIES:** Please purchase tickets (\$1 each) prior to the Show at the Secretary's Office and provide contact details.
- **Entries must be in screw top jars. Sauce style bottles are to be used for sauce.**
